

REGIONS BEYOND: Hindu customs and rituals are often blended into Christianity in India. It is not unusual for Hindus who convert to Christianity to retain their customs, including the caste system. Although Christianity came to India in 52 AD, today it represents 2.3% of the population and is concentrated in a few remote areas of the nation. Hinduism has over one million followers, while Islam has become the fastest growing religion in India with nearly 15% of the population having converted.





Please pray for Bruce's safety as he travels and ministers. **Visa Renewals . . .** Due to security concerns, many countries are now requiring entry visas to be applied for in a persons home country. These new measures have begun to force us to apply for entry and residence visas at the embassy in the United States or risk being denied entry upon arrival. **North Africa . . .** Crusades are planned for several locations in North Africa over the next year with the first taking place this summer. Fortunately, the hottest months are April and May, but it never gets too cool in the desert.
